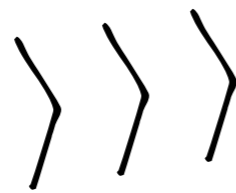

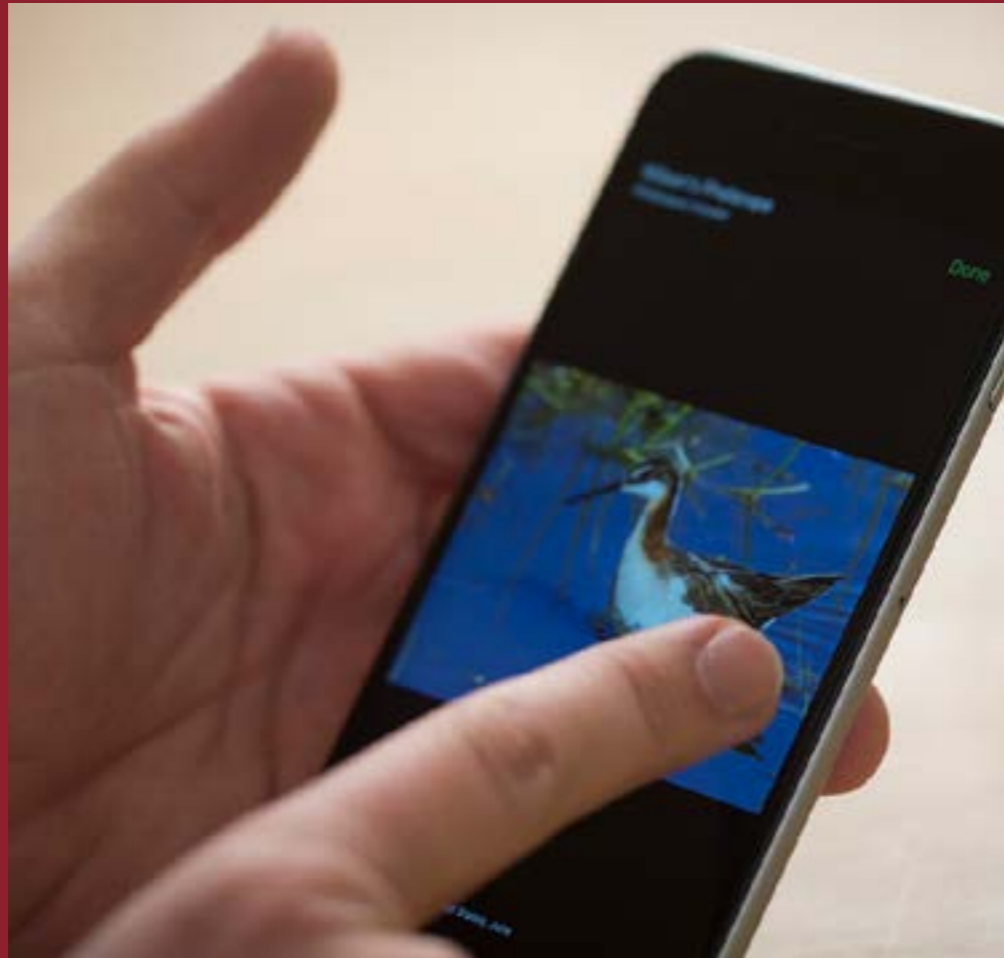


# Climate-Friendly Recipe



## Explore

Did you know that you can use a smart phone to identify birds in your neighborhood?



Grab your smart phone (or that of your parent or older sibling) and download the [Merlin Bird ID app](#) to explore all the birdlife in your area.

By just describing the size, color, and location of a bird, you can identify what it is and hear recordings of its bird call! Every time you identify a bird, that information is sent to Cornell University where scientists use it to track birds and their migration patterns.
